- Coastal Hydrodynamic and Geotechnical Issues Caused by Earthquake and Subsequent Tsunami
- Tsunami Detection by Deepwater Seabed Sensors and Buoys and Radar
- Experimental and Numerical Methods on Tsunami, Long Waves
- Comprehensive Simulation Model for Tsunami Runup, Deformation of Structures, Scouring, Drift and Oil Diffusion
- Tsunami Protection/Reduction Measures (i.e. coastal protection facility, green belt, etc.)
- Worst Case Scenario and Resilient Coastal Community
- Evacuation Simulation and Safe Evacuation Planning
- AI and IoT Technologies for Disaster Prevention/Mitigation Measures and Tsunami Prediction
- Post-Event Problems (i.e. tidal flooding, landslide, floating debris, etc.)

All papers accepted upon peer-review will be published in ISOPE conference proceedings indexed by Engineering Index, EI (Compendex), Scopus, Thomson ISTP, Google Scholar and more. High-quality papers may be selected for further review for publication on The *International Journal of Offshore and Polar Engineering*, indexed by Science Citation Index- E.
