ISOPE Actions Taken in Response to Student Suggestions at Prior Student Forums (2005–2015)

- Journal abstracts and selected papers were posted on the ISOPE web site. All hard-copy ISOPE publications have been digitized and are available to student members (five papers free per year).
- Continuity of Networking
- Student Forum participants received ISOPE pocket calendars (discontinued in 2015.)
- ISOPE office sent **ISOPE** baggage tags to all registered students. (discontinued in 2014.)
- Best student papers in recent ISOPE conferences were uploaded to the website.
- www.isopec.org webpage is annually upgraded including SEO.
- ISOPE converts **journal** manuscripts in either WORD or LaTeX to ISOPE journal template in LaTeX. LaTeX users submit manuscripts in PDF for review, and revised manuscript in either WORD or LaTeX but with PDF file.
- All ISOPE conference and symposium publications are indexed by **EI Compendex, Engineering Index, Fluidex, ISTP/ISI, Google Scholar, Scopus** and more. Journal is further indexed by **SCI-E**.
- All ISOPE-published papers are online available globally from www.onepetro.org (your university library already may be subscribing).
